What differentiates project management from program management?

PROJECT MANAGEMENT

- Process of delivering value that incrementally moves tasks forward
- Focused on outputs
- Tracked within phases on time delivery, within budget, stakeholder approval
- Examples: chemistry analyzer vendor change; consolidation of microbiology between labs; optimization of pre-analytic section

PROGRAM MANAGEMENT

- Process of planning, management, and execution of multiple related projects to improve organizational performance
- Focused on outcomes
- Aligned with strategy
- Examples: planning & execution of Outreach sale to commercial lab; productivity improvements from work consolidation
